### What is the basis for the exams?

The ICESA exam is based on a reference model, a dictionary of terms and concepts, boring to read.

Our training courses bring it to life using examples, methodology, exercises and a case study.

However, for examination purposes, you revise by reading the reference model.

The PCESA exam is based on the case study used in the course.

### Where do I find the reference model for the ICESA exam?

Avancier's version of the reference model is published on slide shows with graphics.

The relevant slide shows are numbered 1 to 9.

You may find reading them before the course difficult, and in practice, much of it is not examined.

However, looking through the slide shows will give you a heads up for the exam revision day.

So, see what you understand; skip over what you don't understand; and don't try to memorise it!

### How does the course run?

Day 1: ESA sections 1, 2 and 3 – revise those sections after the class

Day 2: ESA sections 4, 5 and 6 – revise those sections after the class

Day 3: ESA sections 7, 8 and 9 – revise those sections after the class.

Day 4: ICESA exam day: exam preparation quizzes, mock exam and **real exam**

Day 5: PCESA exam day: additional topics and case study work, mock exam and **real exam**.

For on-line customers, we book **remote-proctored exams** from the BCS, each for up to 4 people.

The exam preparation may finish on days 4 and 5 earlier than 16.00.

But to be on the safe side, we book the exams for 16.00 to 17.00.
